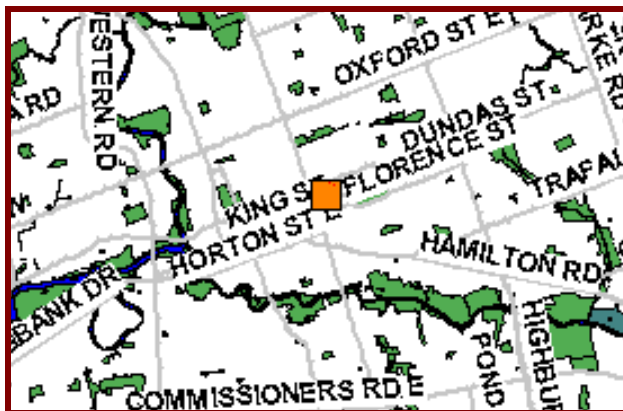

Founded in 1847, the London Curling Club is one of the oldest curling clubs in Canada. Originally, games were played outdoors on the coves near the Thames River. In 1910, the club moved indoors, and in 1915, the site of the existing club was purchased. Artificial ice was installed in 1929—a London first!

The LCC has co-hosted several major curling events: the Canadian Men's Championship ('74), the World Curling Championship ('81) and the Canadian Women's Championship ('86) and ('06). In March 2011, the Brier (Men's Championship) will be returning to London. Join us for the excitement!

LCC CURLING ACTIVITIES

Curling activities occur seven days a week from early October until the beginning of April. There are a variety of leagues to accommodate everyone's needs and preferences... from age 8 to 80!

MEN'S LEAGUES

Men's curling is scheduled Monday through Thursday in the evenings, as well as Monday and Thursday afternoons. In addition, the senior men enjoy social curling almost every weekday.

WOMEN'S LEAGUES

There are daytime and evening leagues, some social and others more competitive. While the competitive leagues have team registration, single members are always encouraged to sign up as spares.

MIXED LEAGUES

There are mixed leagues four evenings a week, offering a variety of competition levels, from the social "Learn-to-Curl" league on Tuesdays to the mixed competitive league on Fridays.

POST-SECONDARY

University and college students can take advantage of a special reduced membership rate.

BANTAM & JUNIOR CURLING

Sunday afternoons at 1 PM are set aside for bantam (grades 6 to 8) and junior (high school age) curling. Both instruction and games are scheduled.

LITTLE ROCK CURLING

Using smaller rocks and half a sheet of ice, youngsters from grades 3 to 5 (age 8 to 10) learn how to curl with the help of adult instructors. The emphasis is completely on fun!
